Plan your transition to electric vehicles

Internal combustion engines are a leading source of emissions. Transitioning vehicles from internal combustion engines to zero-emission propulsion is an important component of the State's Climate Action Plan. Municipalities have a wide range of vehicles across their fleet, varying from light-duty cars (e.g. police cruisers and inspection vehicles) to medium and heavy-duty (box trucks and shuttles). Through this action municipalities can plan their transition to electric vehicles in a thoughtful and efficient manner by starting with an inventory of all fleet vehicles.

Earn recognition and unlock access to grant funding

NYSERDA's Clean Energy Communities Program recognizes and rewards local governments for their clean energy leadership.

Each High Impact Action is worth points collected upon completion of the action. The points you earn count toward unlocking access to Designation Grant funding. Earning more points allows you to reach higher designation levels and to earn larger amounts of grant funding.
