

**NYSERDA Program Announcement  
New York Green Residential Building Program  
May 2, 2012**

Dear Building Owners and Technicians,

As you may know, building owners intending to apply for New York Green Residential Building Program (GRBP) incentives in 2012-2013 have been encouraged to work with their respective GRBP Technicians to provide an Incentive Reservation Form (IRF) to NYSERDA. Due to the volume of IRFs received, funding currently allocated to the GRBP is nearly completely committed.

Please see the conditions below to understand how this may affect your building project(s).

1. Projects with approved IRFs:

Owners that have submitted IRFs and have received NYSERDA approval via e-mail have funding reserved for their building(s) and should submit incentive application packages for payment as buildings are completed. Please note that, per the IRF, owners are obligated to notify NYSERDA if buildings will not complete (or will not meet GRBP requirements) at least 90 days prior to the estimated construction completion date stated on the IRF. This will allow NYSERDA to release these funds so they can be available for other projects.

2. Projects with IRFs submitted, but not approved:

Owners that have submitted IRFs but have not received NYSERDA approval have been placed on a wait list. NYSERDA will notify you **if** additional funding becomes available in the amount requested for your building. Building owners with signed IRFs on the wait list will receive funding on a first-come, first served basis if funding becomes available. NYSERDA cannot guarantee that additional funds will become available for the GRBP. Accordingly, please note that you proceed with your building project with the risk not being able to obtain the GRBP incentive for your project.

3. Projects where IRF has not been submitted:

At this time, NYSERDA is not accepting any additional IRFs. NYSERDA cannot guarantee that additional funds will become available for the GRBP. Accordingly, please note that you proceed with the risk of not being able to obtain the GRBP incentive for your project.

Any additional funding for GRBP will largely be dependent on the outcome of future Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative (RGGI) auctions. As NYSERDA cannot predict with certainty the amount of funding that will be allocated to the GRBP from future auctions, NYSERDA must take the steps detailed above to ensure that the program is not over-subscribed.
