2012-13 Home Energy Assistance Program

- ▶ November 2012 Federal Appropriation \$3.5B
- ▶ March 2013 Sequestration \$3.068B
- ▶ NYS's allocation is \$339M (to date)
- ▶ 1.45M households served (to date)

2012-13 HEAP Program Year

Component	Opening Date	Closing Date
Regular	November 19, 2012	March 15, 2013
Emergency	January 2, 2013	March 15, 2013
Heating Equipment	October 1, 2012	February 1, 2013
Cooling Assistance	April 1, 2013	August 30, 2013

2012-13

REGULAR BENEFIT AMOUNTS

- ▶ Heat included with rent
 - Tier I = \$25
 - Tier II = \$20

- ▶ Oil, kerosene, propane = \$600
- ▶ Wood, coal, other deliverable = \$500
- ▶ Natural gas or electric = \$400
 - Add ons:
 - Income in Tier I = \$25
 - Vulnerable household member = \$25

2012-13 EMERGENCY BENEFITS

- ▶ Oil, kerosene, propane = \$600
- ▶ Wood, coal, other deliverable = \$500
- ▶ Natural gas heat only = \$400
- ▶ Natural gas and electric = \$560
- ▶ Electric heat = \$560
- ▶ Heat-related electric = \$160
- ▶ Propane Installation/Deposit = \$500/year
- ▶ Temporary Relocation = \$500/year
- ▶ Heating Equipment Repair = \$3,000/year
- ▶ Heating Equipment Replacement = \$6,500/ten year period

2013-14 HEAP Season

- ▶ President's proposed budget appropriation \$3.02B
- ▶ NYS share ?? – potentially \$303M
- ▶ Serve the same number of households
- ▶ Similar benefit structure
- ▶ Similar program timeframes opening/closing dates
- ▶ myBenefits will be available statewide with the exception of NYC in August

Applying for Benefits

- ▶ When the user submits an application through myBenefits, they will be able to:
 - **Print the application**
 - **Track the application**
 - **Submit required documentation.**

**If the district that the applicant is applying in has IEDR, then the applicant will have the ability to scan in their required documentation.

Timeframes and Notices

- ▶ The local district has 30 business days to process all regular HEAP benefit applications
- ▶ The 30 business day processing requirement includes the issuance of all eligibility notices within 30 business days of the receipt of a signed, completed application
