Join an energy study portfolio

By joining in an energy study aggregation portfolio, you can be part of a new approach to receiving energy audits. The goal of the program is for NYSERDA-approved FlexTech consultants to provide streamlined, reduced-cost energy or retrocommissioning studies by leveraging a group of similar participant sites in need of comparable services.

Energy efficiency and retrocommissioning studies provide straightforward investment recommendations that lead to reduced building operating costs and increased occupant comfort by identifying cost-effective energy efficiency upgrades and optimal equipment operating parameters.

Through the Energy Study Aggregation Program, you can:

- Receive an objective energy audit or retrocommissioning study from a NYSERDA FlexTech consultant.
- Identify opportunities to reduce energy use.
- Receive quantified energy cost savings.

Eligible study areas can:

- Target a specific building technology, piece of equipment, or system.
- Encompass a comprehensive whole building energy or retrocommissioning approach.

Eligible aggregation portfolio participants must:

- Be a commercial facility, such as office, health care, retail, school/university, state/local government, small business, not-for-profit.
- Have a similar building attribute, such as building type, equipment type, operating schedule, location, energy or retrocommissioning study need.
- Pay into the electric System Benefit Charge (SBC).

How to Participate

- Contact a FlexTech consultant to discuss your facility's energy study needs and inquire about their potential Energy Study Aggregation projects.
- Find a FlexTech consultant at nyserdera.ny.gov/FlexTech-Consultants
- Reach out to NYSERDA to be added to a pool of potential participant sites.

Program Process

- Join a FlexTech consultant's aggregation project by contracting directly with a FlexTech consultant to receive a study.
- Work with the FlexTech consultant to submit a participant site application to NYSERDA.
- The FlexTech consultant will perform the study and deliver a draft report for review.
- NYSERDA will review the report for technical soundness.
- The FlexTech consultant will update the report based on NYSERDA's feedback and issue a final report.



Study Cost

- The FlexTech consultant sets the cost of the study. NYSERDA provides incentives directly to the FlexTech consultant to use at their discretion.
