Due to Long Island's enormous interest and success in adding solar power, the final residential MW Block for that region is nearly filled, however I am pleased to announce that NY-Sun is adding approximately 18 more MW. The additional megawatts are from unfulfilled residential projects. Based on the current rate of applications, we expect these additional megawatts to extend the residential MW Block for another three to four months, at which time no more State residential solar incentives will be available as Long Island progresses to a self-sustaining solar market. Thank you for your continued partnership in accelerating the growth of solar energy in New York State.
