- Should continue engagement, outreach, education, and support for local municipalities, communities, and residents to increase awareness and improve acceptance of energy delivery projects
- And, continue to encourage and facilitate collaboration between the renewable energy industry and the farming community to advance the objectives of the CLCPA while preserving the State's vital agricultural sector



In conclusion, thank you to NY's Climate Action Council for their deliberation and their development of the draft plan. At Liberty, we know that implementing this aggressive plan will complicated and ensuring that new renewable energy gets built will also not be easy.
