
Highlights

- Mid-Atlantic ultra-low sulfur (ULS) distillate inventories, including diesel fuel and New York State heating oil, have declined for seven weeks in a row. Inventories have declined by 31.1% over that time period but remain 38.5% above the 5-year average.
- Since October 1, cumulative New York Statewide heating degree-days are currently 34.6% below the normal.
- New York statewide average retail prices for ultra-low sulfur (ULS) heating oil and kerosene declined while the propane price increased since last week.

Retail Petroleum Prices—On a statewide basis since the last survey on October 21st, prices decreased 2.1¢/gallon (0.5%) to 391.0¢/gallon for ULS heating oil, 1.1¢/gallon (0.3%) to 422.3¢/gallon for kerosene, and increased 5.1¢/gallon (1.9%) to 278.2¢/gallon for propane. Compared to a year earlier, prices decreased 19.6¢/gallon (4.8%) for heating oil, 12.1¢/gallon (2.8%) for kerosene and increased 12.3¢/gallon (4.6%) for propane.

Crude Oil Prices—For the week ending 10/25/13, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$97.57/bbl, a decrease of \$3.94/bbl (3.9%) from the week-ago average of \$101.51/bbl. WTI prices are now \$11.22/bbl (13.0%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$86.35/bbl. The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred on 7/03/08.

Spot Natural Gas Prices—For the week ending 10/25/13, Henry Hub natural gas spot prices averaged \$3.690 per million Btu (mmBtu), a decrease of \$0.100/mmBtu (2.6%) from the prior week level of \$3.790/mmBtu. Prices are currently \$0.288/mmBtu (8.5%) above the year-earlier weekly average of \$3.402/mmBtu.



Residential Natural Gas Prices—The NYS average price in July 2013 was \$1.831/therm, an increase of \$0.032/therm (1.8%) from the prior month of \$1.799/therm, and was \$0.167/therm (10.0%) higher than the year earlier average of \$1.664/therm.

Historic Retail Prices—Statewide average high and low prices since Sept. 1997 for #2 & propane & Sept. 2000 for kerosene.


- Heating oil—highest price 477.8¢/gallon on 7/14/08, lowest price 87.6¢/gallon on 9/08/98.

Heating Degree Days—On a statewide basis during the past week, the number of heating degree days (116) was 87.1% above the year-ago level of (62) and 7.4% above the normal trend (108). On a cumulative basis since October 1st, current year heating degree days (219) are behind the year-ago level (257) by 14.8% and trail the normal trend (335) by 34.6%.




