## Highlights

- In the past week, the New York State average-weekly retail gasoline price was $\$ 3.949 /$ gallon, down $2.3 \$ /$ gallon ( $0.6 \%$ ) from the prior week and down $5.5 ¢ /$ gallon (1.4\%) from the year-ago price. Diesel was $\$ 4.390 /$ gallon, down $1.5 ¢ /$ gallon ( $0.3 \%$ ) from the prior week and down $0.6 \$ /$ gallon ( $0.1 \%$ ) above the year-ago price.
- Crude oil prices continued to decline this week; WTI and Brent are down $12.7 \%$ and $14.1 \%$ from the prior year, respectively.
- Total U.S. gasoline demand was 8.3 million barrels per day; down $3.5 \%$ from the prior week, down $0.7 \%$ from a year ago, and $6.7 \%$ below the five-year average.


## Retail Prices

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

Regular Gasoline- As of March 20, 2013, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average regular gasoline price equaled $\$ 3.938 /$ gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of $\$ 4.022 /$ gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.084/gallon (2.1\%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

Diesel— As of March 20, 2013, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average diesel price equaled $\$ 4.383 /$ gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of $\$ 4.404 /$ gallon, the statewide average has decreased $\$ 0.020 /$ gallon ( $0.5 \%$ ).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.

## Crude Oil Spot Prices

WTI-For the week ending March 15, 2013, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged $\$ 92.70 / \mathrm{bbl}$, an increase of $\$ 1.70 / \mathrm{bbl}$ ( $1.9 \%$ ) from the prior week average of $\$ 91.00 / \mathrm{bbl}$. WTI prices are now \$13.45/bbl (12.7\%) below the year-ago weekly average of $\$ 106.32 / \mathrm{bbl}$.

The all-time weekly average high of $\$ 142.52 / \mathrm{bbl}$ occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent-For the week ending March 15, 2013, Brent
 crude oil spot prices averaged $\$ 108.41 / \mathrm{bbl}$, a decrease of $\$ 1.57 / \mathrm{bbl}(1.4 \%)$ from the week-ago average of $\$ 109.98 / \mathrm{bbl}$. Brent prices are now $\$ 17.81 / \mathrm{bbl}$ ( $14.1 \%$ ) below the year-ago weekly average of $\$ 126.22 / \mathrm{bbl}$.

The all-time weekly average high of $\$ 141.07 / \mathrm{bbl}$ occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
