## **Highlights**

- In the past week, the New York State average-weekly retail gasoline price was \$3.912/gallon, down  $1.9\phi$ /gallon (0.5%) from the prior week and up  $12.7\phi$ /gallon (3.4%) from the year-ago price.
- Diesel was \$4.206/gallon, down 0.2¢/gallon (0.0%) from the prior week and up 11.5¢/gallon (2.8%) from the year-ago price.
- Mid-Atlantic gasoline inventories remain well supplied; up 3.2% from last week and 28.9% above last year.

## **Retail Prices**

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

**Regular Gasoline**— As of August 7, 2013, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average regular gasoline price equaled \$3.899/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.832/gallon, the statewide average has increased \$0.67/gallon (1.7%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

**Diesel**— As of August 7, 2013, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average diesel price equaled \$4.207/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.103/gallon, the statewide average has increased \$0.104/gallon (2.5%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.

## **Crude Oil Spot Prices**




WTI—For the week ending Aug 2, 2013, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$105.54/bbl, a decrease of \$0.34/bbl (0.3%) from the prior week average of \$105.88/bbl. WTI prices are now \$16.44/bbl (18.5%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$89.10/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

**Brent**—For the week ending Aug 2, 2013, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$108.61/bbl, an increase of \$0.21/bbl (0.2%) from the week-ago average of \$108.40/bbl. Brent prices are now \$1.34/bbl (1.2%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$105.40/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.


