## **Highlights**

- In the past week, the New York State average-weekly retail gasoline price was \$3.851/gallon, up 1.0¢/gallon (0.3%) from the prior week and down 14.2¢/gallon (3.5%) from the year-ago price.
- Diesel was \$4.200/gallon, up 0.8¢/gallon (0.2%) from the prior week and down 8.4¢/gallon (2.0%) from the year-ago price.
- Mid-Atlantic ultra-low sulfur highway diesel inventories remain well supplied; up 110.7% from last year.

## **Retail Prices**

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

**Regular Gasoline**— As of September 4, 2013, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average regular gasoline price equaled \$3.876/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.007gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.131/gallon (3.3%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

**Diesel**— As of September 4, 2013, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average diesel price equaled \$4.226/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.292/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.066/gallon (1.5%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.


## **Crude Oil Spot Prices**



WTI—For the week ending Aug 30, 2013, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$108.33/bbl, a decrease of \$2.85/bbl (2.7%) from the prior week average of \$105.48/bbl. WTI prices are now \$12.65/bbl (13.2%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$95.68/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

**Brent**—For the week ending Aug 30, 2013, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$115.32/bbl, an increase of \$4.20/bbl (3.8%) from the week-ago average of \$111.12/bbl. Brent prices are now \$2.30/bbl (2.0%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$113.02/bbl.





The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
