## NYSERDA Transportation Fuels Report

## **Highlights**

- In the past week, the New York State average-weekly retail gasoline price was \$3.812/gallon, down 3.8¢/gallon (1.0%) from the prior week and down  $31.2\phi/gallon (7.6\%)$  from the year-ago price.
- Diesel was 4.214/gallon, down 1.0¢/gallon (0.2%) from the prior week and down 14.2¢/gallon (3.2%) from the year-ago price.
- Mid-Atlantic ultra-low sulfur highway diesel inventories remain well supplied; up 112.7% from last year.

## **Retail Prices**

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

**Regular Gasoline**— As of September 25, 2013, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average regular gasoline price equaled \$3.773/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.096/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.323/gallon (7.9%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

Diesel— As of September 25, 2013, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average diesel price equaled \$4.205/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.344/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.139/gallon (3.2%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.

## **Crude Oil Spot Prices**



WTI—For the week ending September 20, 2013, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$106.22/bbl, a decrease of \$2.14/bbl (2.0%) from the prior week average of \$108.36/bbl. WTI prices are now \$12.52/bbl (13.4%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$93.70/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

**Brent**—For the week ending September 20, 2013, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$109.98/bbl, a decrease of \$3.24/bbl (2.9%) from the week-ago average of \$113.22/bbl. Brent prices are now \$1.85/bbl (1.7%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$111.83/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.




