## **Highlights**

- In the past week, the New York State average-weekly retail gasoline price was \$3.645/gallon, up 1.0¢/gallon (0.3%) from the prior week and down 19.2¢/gallon (5.0%) from the year-ago price.
- Diesel was \$4.157/gallon, up 1.2¢/gallon (0.3%) from the prior week and down 21.4¢/gallon (4.9%) from the year-ago price.
- Mid-Atlantic inventories of gasoline and diesel increased in the past week by 7.6% and 7.0%, respectively.

## **Retail Prices**

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

**Regular Gasoline**— As of December 11, 2013, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average regular gasoline price equaled \$3.661/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.803/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.142/gallon (3.7%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

**Diesel**— As of December 11, 2013, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average diesel price equaled \$4.175/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.358/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.183/gallon (4.2%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.


## **Crude Oil Spot Prices**



WTI—For the week ending December 6, 2013, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$96.21/bbl, an increase of \$3.24 /bbl (3.5%) from the prior week average of \$92.97/bbl. WTI prices are now \$9.21/bbl (10.6%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$87.00/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

**Brent**—For the week ending December 6, 2013, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$112.28/bbl, an increase of \$0.96/bbl (0.9%) from the week-ago average of \$111.32/bbl. Brent prices are now \$3.20/bbl (2.9%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$109.08/bbl.





The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
