Highlights

- In the past week, the New York State average-weekly retail gasoline price was \$3.662/gallon, up 1.7ϕ /gallon (0.5%) from the prior week and down 11.6ϕ /gallon (3.1%) from the year-ago price.
- Diesel was \$4.172/gallon, up 1.4¢/gallon (0.3%) from the prior week and down 17.6¢/gallon (4.0%) from the year-ago price.

Retail Prices

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

Regular Gasoline— As of December 18, 2013, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average regular gasoline price equaled \$3.665/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.748/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.083/gallon (2.2%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th. 2008.

Diesel— As of December 18, 2013, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average diesel price equaled \$4.176/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.331/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.155/gallon (3.6%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June

18th, 2008.





WTI—For the week ending December 13, 2013, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$97.23/bbl, an increase of \$1.02 /bbl (1.1%) from the prior week average of \$96.21/bbl. WTI prices are now \$11.52/bbl (13.4%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$85.71/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent—For the week ending December 13, 2013, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$109.10/bbl, a decrease of \$3.18/bbl (2.8%) from the week-ago average of \$112.28/bbl. Brent prices are now \$0.27/bbl (0.2%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$108.83/bbl.





The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
