## **Highlights**

- In the past week, the New York State average-weekly retail gasoline price equaled \$3.643/gallon, down 2.5¢/gallon (0.7%) from the prior week and down 8.3¢/gallon (2.2%) from the year-ago price.
- Diesel was \$4.212/gallon, up 1.7¢/gallon (0.4%) from the prior week and down 10.5¢/gallon (2.4%) from the year-ago price.
- Mid-Atlantic highway diesel inventories decreased 7.5% from the prior week and stocks are 28.3% below yearago levels. Demand for ULS distillate for home heating due to persistent cold weather is contributing to this decline.

## **Retail Prices**

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

**Regular Gasoline**— As of January 29, 2014, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average regular gasoline price equaled \$3.637/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.747/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.110/gallon (2.9%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

**Diesel**— As of January 29, 2014, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average diesel price equaled \$4.297/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.325/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.028/gallon (0.6%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.


## **Crude Oil Spot Prices**



WTI—For the week ending January 24, 2014, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$96.19/bbl, an increase of \$3.21/bbl (3.5%) from the prior week average of \$92.98/bbl. WTI prices are now \$0.78/bbl (0.8%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$95.41/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

**Brent**—For the week ending January 24, 2014, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$109.14/bbl, an increase of \$1.31/bbl (1.2%) from the week-ago average of \$107.83/bbl. Brent prices are now





\$4.58/bbl (4.0%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$113.72/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
