## **Highlights**

- In the past week, the New York State average weekly retail gasoline price equaled \$3.697/gallon, up 5.2¢/gallon (1.4%) from the prior week and down 30.9¢/gallon (7.7%) from the year-ago price.
- Diesel was \$4.462/gallon, up 0.6¢/gallon (0.1%) from the prior week and up 4.1¢/gallon (0.9%) from the year-ago price.
- Mid-Atlantic highway diesel inventories increased 3.1% from the prior week yet are 11.3% below year-ago levels.

## **Retail Prices**

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

**Regular Gasoline**— As of February 26, 2014, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average regular gasoline price equaled \$3.729/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.014/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.285/gallon (7.1%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

**Diesel**— As of February 26, 2014, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average diesel price equaled \$4.472/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.426/gallon, the statewide average has increased \$0.046/gallon (1.0%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.

## **Crude Oil Spot Prices**




WTI—For the week ending February 21, 2014, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$102.93/bbl, an increase of \$2.72/bbl (2.7%) from the prior week average of \$100.21/bbl. WTI prices are now \$8.55/bbl (9.1%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$94.38/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

**Brent**—For the week ending February 21, 2014, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$109.74/bbl, an increase of \$0.62/bbl (0.6%) from the week-ago average of \$109.12/bbl. Brent prices are now \$5.56/bbl (4.8%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$115.30/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
