Highlights

- In the past week, the New York State average weekly retail gasoline price equaled \$3.772/gallon, the same price as the prior week and down 13.5¢/gallon (3.5%) from the year-ago price.
- The New York State average weekly retail diesel price was \$4.421/gallon, down 1.6¢/gallon (0.4%) from the prior week and up 6.6¢/gallon (1.5%) from the year-ago price.
- East Coast ethanol inventories increased 6.1% in the past week but are down 18.9% from the prior year. As a percentage of East Coast gasoline inventory, ethanol stocks were 9.1% as compared to 10.7% a year ago.

Retail Prices

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

Regular Gasoline— As of April 2, 2014, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average regular gasoline price equaled \$3.779/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.893/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.114/gallon (2.9%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

Diesel— As of April 2, 2014, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average diesel price equaled \$4.413/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.342/gallon, the statewide average has increased \$0.071/gallon (1.6%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.






WTI—For the week ending March 28, 2014, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$100.66/bbl, an increase of \$0.89/bbl (0.9%) from the prior week average of \$99.77/bbl. WTI prices are now \$4.58/bbl (4.8%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$96.08/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent—For the week ending March 28, 2014, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$106.54/bbl, an increase of \$0.01/bbl (0.0%) from the week-ago average of \$106.53/bbl. Brent prices are now \$1.14/bbl (1.1%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$107.68/bbl.





The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
