## **Highlights**

- In the past week, the New York State average weekly retail gasoline price equaled \$3.776/gallon, up  $0.4\phi$ /gallon (0.1%) from the prior week and down  $10.1\phi$ /gallon (2.6%) from the year-ago price.
- The New York State average weekly retail diesel price was \$4.406/gallon, down 1.6¢/gallon (0.4%) from the prior week and up 6.8¢/gallon (1.6%) from the year-ago price.

## **Retail Prices**

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

**Regular Gasoline**— As of April 9, 2014, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average regular gasoline price equaled \$3.777/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.847/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.070/gallon (1.8%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

**Diesel**— As of April 9, 2014, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average diesel price equaled \$4.401/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.320/gallon, the statewide average has increased \$0.081/gallon (1.9%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.


## **Crude Oil Spot Prices**



WTI—For the week ending April 4, 2014, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$100.45/bbl, a decrease of \$0.20/bbl (0.2%) from the prior week average of \$100.66/bbl. WTI prices are now \$5.39/bbl (5.7%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$95.07/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

**Brent**—For the week ending April 4, 2014, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$105.26/bbl, a decrease of \$1.28/bbl (1.2%) from the week-ago average of \$106.54/bbl. Brent prices are now \$1.80/bbl (1.7%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$107.06/bbl.





The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
