## Highlights

- In the past week, the New York State average weekly retail gasoline price equaled $\$ 3.878 /$ gallon, down $0.4 \Phi /$ gallon ( $0.1 \%$ ) from the prior week and $13.5 \$ /$ gallon (3.6\%) higher than the year-ago price.
- The New York State average weekly retail diesel price was $\$ 4.291 /$ gallon, down $0.6 \$ /$ gallon ( $0.1 \%$ ) from the prior week and up 11.6\$/gallon (2.8\%) from the year-ago price.
- Total U.S. gasoline production decreased by 0.6 million barrels (6.6\%) to 8.9 million barrels and is now $3.8 \%$ below last year's level of 9.2 million barrels and $4.6 \%$ below the 5 -year average of 9.3 million barrels.


## Retail Prices

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."
Regular Gasoline- As of June 11, 2014, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average regular gasoline price equaled $\$ 3.875 /$ gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of $\$ 3.742 /$ gallon, the statewide average has increased \$0.133/gallon (3.6\%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

Diesel— As of June 11, 2014, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average diesel price equaled $\$ 4.289 /$ gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of $\$ 4.169 /$ gallon, the statewide average has increased \$0.120/gallon (2.9\%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June
 18th, 2008.

## Crude Oil Spot Prices

WTI—For the week ending June 6, 2014, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged $\$ 103.23 / \mathrm{bbl}$, a decrease of $\$ 0.72 / \mathrm{bbl}$ ( $0.7 \%$ ) from the prior week average of $\$ 103.95 / \mathrm{bbl}$. WTI prices are now \$8.98/bbl (9.5\%) above the year-ago weekly average of $\$ 94.25 / \mathrm{bbl}$.

The all-time weekly average high of $\$ 142.52 / \mathrm{bbl}$ occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent—For the week ending June 6, 2014, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged $\$ 108.98 / \mathrm{bbl}$, a decrease of $\$ 0.64 / \mathrm{bbl}(0.6 \%)$ from the week-ago average of \$109.62/bbl. Brent prices are now \$6.06/bbl (5.9\%) above the year-ago weekly average of $\$ 102.92 / \mathrm{bbl}$.


The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
