## **Highlights**

- In the past week, the New York State average weekly retail gasoline price equaled \$3.765/gallon, down 3.3¢/gallon (0.9%) from the prior week and 9.2¢/gallon (2.4%) lower than the year-ago price.
- The New York State average weekly retail diesel price was \$4.178/gallon, down  $2.0\phi$ /gallon (0.5%) from the prior week and  $1.0\phi$ /gallon (0.2%) lower than the year-ago price.
- WTI crude oil spot prices have fallen for the third week in a row to \$97.17/barrel, a decrease of \$0.33/barrel (0.3%) from last week price of \$97.50/barrel and 9.2% below last year's average of \$106.97/barrel.

## **Retail Prices**

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

**Regular Gasoline**— As of August 20, 2014, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average regular gasoline price equaled \$3.737/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.848/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.111/gallon (2.9%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

**Diesel**— As of August 20, 2014, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average diesel price equaled \$4.166/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.192/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.026/gallon (0.6%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.


## **Crude Oil Spot Prices**



WTI—For the week ending August 15, 2014, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$97.17/bbl, a decrease of \$0.33/bbl (0.3%) from the prior week average of \$97.50/bbl. WTI prices are now \$9.80/bbl (9.2%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$106.97/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

**Brent**—For the week ending August 15, 2014, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$101.94/bbl, a decrease of \$1.66/bbl (1.6%) from the week-ago average of \$103.60/bbl. Brent prices are now \$8.79/bbl (7.9%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$110.73/bbl.





The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.


