## **Highlights**

- In the past week, the New York State average weekly retail gasoline price equaled \$3.707/gallon, down  $2.1\phi$ /gallon (0.6%) from the prior week and  $14.4\phi$ /gallon (3.8%) lower than the year-ago price.
- The New York State average weekly retail diesel price was \$4.139/gallon, down  $1.8\phi$ /gallon (0.4%) from the prior week and  $6.1\phi$ /gallon (1.5%) lower than the year-ago price.
- European Brent crude oil spot prices are currently \$100.64/barrel, a decrease of \$14.68/barrel (12.7%) from last year's average of \$115.32/barrel and \$12.49/barrel (11.0%) lower than the three year average of \$113.13/barrel.

## **Retail Prices**

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

**Regular Gasoline**— As of September 3, 2014, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average regular gasoline price equaled \$3.696/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.871/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.175/gallon (4.5%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

**Diesel**— As of September 3, 2014, the most recent daily price available, the statewide average diesel price equaled \$4.128/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.219/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.091/gallon (2.2%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.

## **Crude Oil Spot Prices**


WTI—For the week ending August 29, 2014, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$96.25/bbl, an increase of \$1.30/bbl (1.4%) from the prior week average of \$94.95/bbl. WTI prices are now \$12.08/bbl (11.2%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$108.33/bbl.


The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

**Brent**—For the week ending August 29, 2014, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$100.64/bbl, an increase of \$0.76/bbl (0.8%) from the week-ago average of \$99.88/bbl. Brent prices are now

\$14.68/bbl (12.7%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$115.32/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
