## Highlights

- The weekly average New York State retail diesel price decreased $\$ 0.032 /$ gallon from last week's average to $\$ 3.320 /$ gallon and is now $\$ 1.086 / \mathrm{gal}(24.7 \%)$ lower than last year's weekly average of $\$ 4.406 /$ gallon.
- Mid-Atlantic ULS diesel stocks increased $12.7 \%$ from last week but are $12.0 \%$ below last year’s level of 11.5 million barrels.
- The weekly average West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude oil spot price increased \$0.27/bbl (0.6\%) from last week. WTI is still $\$ 51.51 / \mathrm{bbl}$ ( $51.3 \%$ ) lower than last year's weekly average price of $\$ 100.46 / \mathrm{bbl}$.


## Retail Prices

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."
Regular Gasoline- For the week ending April $6^{\text {th }}$, the New York State weekly retail gasoline price averaged \$2.566/gallon, a decrease of \$0.009/gallon ( $0.3 \%$ ) from last week's average price of
$\$ 2.575 /$ gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.776/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$1.210/gallon (32.1\%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

Diesel- For the week ending April $6^{\text {th }}$, the New York State weekly retail diesel price averaged $\$ 3.320 /$ gallon, a decrease of $\$ 0.032 /$ gallon (1.0\%) from last week's average price of $\$ 3.352 /$ gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of $\$ 4.406 /$ gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$1.086/gallon (24.7\%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.

## Crude Oil Spot Prices

WTI—For the week ending April 3, 2015, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged $\$ 48.95 / \mathrm{bbl}$, an increase of $\$ 0.27 / \mathrm{bbl}$ ( $0.6 \%$ ) from the prior week average of $\$ 48.68 / \mathrm{bbl}$. WTI prices are now $\$ 51.51 / \mathrm{bbl}$ (51.3\%) below the year-ago weekly average of $\$ 100.46 / \mathrm{bbl}$.

The all-time weekly average high of $\$ 142.52 / \mathrm{bbl}$ occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent-For the week ending April 3, 2015, Brent


crude oil spot prices averaged $\$ 54.97 / \mathrm{bbl}$, a decrease of $\$ 0.04 / \mathrm{bbl}(0.1 \%)$ from the week-ago average of $\$ 55.01 / \mathrm{bbl}$. Brent prices are now $\$ 50.29 / \mathrm{bbl}$ (47.8\%) below the year-ago weekly average of $\$ 105.26 / \mathrm{bbl}$.

The all-time weekly average high of $\$ 141.07 / \mathrm{bbl}$ occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
