## Highlights

- The weekly average New York State regular gasoline price decreased for the sixth week in a row to $\$ 2.823 /$ gallon, and remains $\$ 0.975 /$ gallon (25.7\%) below last year's weekly average price of $\$ 3.798 /$ gallon.
- The weekly average New York State retail diesel price decreased for the thirteenth week in a row to $\$ 3.110 /$ gallon, and remains $\$ 1.088 /$ gallon (25.9\%) below last year's weekly average price of $\$ 4.198 /$ gallon.
- The Brent crude oil spot price decreased for the third week in a row to \$48.59/bbl, decreasing \$5.55/bbl (10.3\%) from last week. Brent prices are now $\$ 55.01 / \mathrm{bbl}$ (53.1\%) below the year-ago weekly average of $\$ 103.60 / \mathrm{bbl}$.


## Retail Prices

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."
Regular Gasoline- For the week ending August $10^{\text {th }}$, the New York State weekly retail gasoline price averaged $\$ 2.823 /$ gallon, a decrease of $\$ 0.040 /$ gallon (1.4\%) from last week's average of $\$ 2.863 /$ gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of $\$ 3.798 /$ gallon, the statewide average has decreased $\$ 0.975 /$ gallon (25.7\%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

Diesel- For the week ending August $10^{\text {th }}$, the New York State weekly retail diesel price averaged \$3.110/gallon, a decrease of \$0.033/gallon (1.1\%) from last week’s average price of $\$ 3.143 /$ gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of $\$ 4.198 /$ gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$1.088/gallon (25.9\%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.

## Crude Oil Spot Prices

WTI—For the week ending August $7^{\text {th }}$, 2015, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged $\$ 44.94 / \mathrm{bbl}$, a decrease of $\$ 2.97 / \mathrm{bbl}$ ( $6.2 \%$ ) from the prior week average of \$47.91/bbl. WTI prices are now \$52.56/bbl (53.9\%) below the year-ago weekly average of $\$ 97.50 / \mathrm{bbl}$.

The all-time weekly average high of $\$ 142.52 / \mathrm{bbl}$ occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent-For the week ending August $7^{\text {th }}, 2015$, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged $\$ 48.59 / b b l$, a decrease of $\$ 5.55 / \mathrm{bbl}$ (10.3\%) from the week-ago average of $\$ 54.14 / \mathrm{bbl}$. Brent prices are now $\$ 55.01 / \mathrm{bbl}$ (53.1\%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$103.60/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
