Highlights

- The weekly average New York State regular gasoline price decreased for the eighth week in a row to \$2.735/gallon, and remains \$0.993/gallon (26.6%) below last year's weekly average price of \$3.728/gallon.
- The weekly average New York State retail diesel price decreased for the fifteenth week in a row to \$3.041/gallon, and remains \$1.116/gallon (26.8%) below last year's weekly average price of \$4.157/gallon.
- The weekly average WTI crude oil spot price decreased for the eighth week in a row to \$41.34/bbl, decreasing by \$1.86/bbl (4.3%) from last week. The weekly average WTI price is now \$53.61/bbl (56.5%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$94.95/bbl.

Retail Prices

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

Regular Gasoline— For the week ending August 24th, the New York State weekly retail gasoline price averaged \$2.735/gallon, a decrease of \$0.042/gallon (1.5%) from last week's average of \$2.777/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.728/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.993/gallon (26.6%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th. 2008.

Diesel— For the week ending August 24th, the New York State weekly retail diesel price averaged \$3.041/gallon, a decrease of \$0.031/gallon (1.0%) from last week's average price of \$3.072/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.157/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$1.116/gallon (26.8%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.





WTI—For the week ending August 21st, 2015, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$41.34/bbl, a decrease of \$1.86/bbl (4.3%) from the prior week average of \$43.20/bbl. WTI prices are now \$53.61/bbl (56.5%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$94.95/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent—For the week ending August 21st, 2015, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$46.00/bbl, a decrease





of \$1.94/bbl (4.0%) from the week-ago average of \$47.94/bbl. Brent prices are now \$53.88/bbl (53.9%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$99.88/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
