## **Highlights**

- The weekly average New York State regular gasoline price decreased for the eleventh week in a row to \$2.569/gallon, and remains \$1.115/gallon (30.3%) below last year's weekly average price of \$3.684/gallon.
- The weekly average New York State retail diesel price decreased for the eighteenth week in a row to \$2.920/gallon, and remains \$1.204/gallon (29.2%) below last year's weekly average price of \$4.124/gallon.
- Mid-Atlantic gasoline stocks increased by 2.5 million barrels to 30 million barrels, an increase of 9.1% since the previous week. The weekly inventory is now 10.1% above the year-ago inventory of 27.3 million barrels.

## **Retail Prices**

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

Regular Gasoline— For the week ending September 14<sup>th</sup>, the New York State weekly retail gasoline price averaged \$2.569/gallon, a decrease of \$0.045/gallon (1.7%) from last week's average of \$2.614/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.684/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$1.115/gallon (30.3%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

**Diesel**— For the week ending September 14<sup>th</sup>, the New York State weekly retail diesel price averaged \$2.920/gallon, a decrease of \$0.036/gallon (1.2%) from last week's average price of \$2.956/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$4.124/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$1.204/gallon (29.2%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.



**WTI**—For the week ending September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2015, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$45.33/bbl, a decrease of \$1.40/bbl (3.0%) from the prior week average of \$46.73/bbl. WTI prices are now \$47.10/bbl (51.0%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$92.43/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$47.60/bbl, a decrease of \$1.09/bbl (2.2%) from the week-ago average of \$48.69/bbl. Brent prices are now \$49.72/bbl (51.1%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$97.32/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.


