## Highlights

- The weekly average New York State regular gasoline price decreased for the thirteenth week in a row to $\$ 2.463 /$ gallon, and remains $\$ 1.156 /$ gallon (31.9\%) below last year's weekly average price of $\$ 3.619 /$ gallon.
- The weekly average New York State retail diesel price decreased for the twentieth week in a row to $\$ 2.856 /$ gallon, and remains $\$ 1.216 /$ gallon (29.9\%) below last year's weekly average price of $\$ 4.072 /$ gallon.
- Mid-Atlantic gasoline stocks increased 2.2\% since last week and are now $15.0 \%$ above last year’s level and $8.0 \%$ above the 5 -year average.


## Retail Prices

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."
Regular Gasoline- For the week ending September $28^{\text {th }}$, the New York State weekly retail gasoline price averaged $\$ 2.463 /$ gallon, a decrease of $\$ 0.050 /$ gallon (2.0\%) from last week's average of \$2.513/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of $\$ 3.619 /$ gallon, the statewide average has decreased $\$ 1.156 /$ gallon (31.9\%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

Diesel- For the week ending September $28^{\text {th }}$, the New York State weekly retail diesel price averaged \$2.856/gallon, a decrease of \$0.031/gallon (1.1\%) from last week’s average price of $\$ 2.887 /$ gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of $\$ 4.072 /$ gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$1.216/gallon (29.9\%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.

## Crude Oil Spot Prices

WTI-For the week ending September 25 ${ }^{\text {th }}$, 2015, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged $\$ 45.57 / \mathrm{bbl}$, an increase of \$0.09/bbl (0.2\%) from the prior week average of $\$ 45.48 / \mathrm{bbl}$. WTI prices are now $\$ 47.58 / \mathrm{bbl}$ (51.1\%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$93.15/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of $\$ 142.52 / b b l$ occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent-For the week ending September 25 ${ }^{\text {th }}$, 2015,



Brent crude oil spot prices averaged $\$ 47.33 / \mathrm{bbl}$, a decrease of $\$ 0.01 / \mathrm{bbl}(0.0 \%)$ from the week-ago average of $\$ 47.34 / \mathrm{bbl}$. Brent prices are now $\$ 47.68 / \mathrm{bbl}$ (50.2\%) below the year-ago weekly average of $\$ 95.01 / \mathrm{bbl}$.

The all-time weekly average high of $\$ 141.07 / b b l$ occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
