## **Highlights**

- The weekly average New York State regular gasoline price decreased for the sixth week in a row to \$2.249/gallon, and is now \$0.592/gallon (20.9%) below last year's weekly average price of \$2.841/gallon.
- The weekly average New York State diesel price decreased for the thirty-third week in a row to \$2.638/gallon, and is now \$1.014/gallon (27.8%) below last year's weekly average price of \$3.652/gallon.
- U.S. crude oil inventories increased by 2.6 million barrels to 487.4 million barrels since last week and are now 26.5% above last year's level of 385.5 million barrels.

## **Retail Prices**

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

**Regular Gasoline**— For the week ending December 28<sup>th</sup>, the New York State weekly retail gasoline price averaged \$2.249/gallon, a decrease of \$0.021/gallon (1.0%) from last week's average of \$2.270/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$2.841/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.592/gallon (20.9%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

**Diesel**— For the week ending December 28<sup>th</sup>, the New York State weekly retail diesel price averaged \$2.638/gallon, a decrease of \$0.034/gallon (1.2%) from last week's average price of \$2.672/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.652/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$1.014/gallon (27.8%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.

## **Crude Oil Spot Prices**

WTI—For the week ending December 25<sup>th</sup>, 2015, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$36.53/bbl, an increase of \$0.75/bbl (2.1%) from the prior week average of \$35.78/bbl. WTI prices are now \$19.05/bbl (34.3%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$55.58/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.



Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$36.14/bbl, a decrease of \$0.70/bbl (1.9%) from the week-ago average of \$36.84/bbl. Brent prices are now \$22.55/bbl (38.4%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$58.69/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.


