Highlights

- The weekly average New York State regular gasoline price decreased for the eighth week in a row to \$2.210/gallon, and is now \$0.458/gallon (17.2%) below last year's weekly average price of \$2.668/gallon.
- The weekly average New York State diesel price decreased for the thirty-fifth week in a row to \$2.586/gallon, and is now \$0.905/gallon (25.9%) below last year's weekly average price of \$3.491/gallon.
- Mid-Atlantic gasoline inventories increased by 2.9 million barrels (9.9%) since last week to 32.1 million barrels, 8.8% higher than the 5-year average.

Retail Prices

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

Regular Gasoline— For the week ending January 11th, 2016 the New York State weekly retail gasoline price averaged \$2.210/gallon, a decrease of \$0.020/gallon (0.9%) from last week's average of \$2.230/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$2.668/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.458/gallon (17.2%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

Diesel— For the week ending January 11th, 2016 the New York State weekly retail diesel price averaged \$2.586/gallon, a decrease of \$0.027/gallon (1.1%) from last week's average price of \$2.613/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.491/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.905/gallon (25.9%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.


Crude Oil Spot Prices



WTI—For the week ending January 8th, 2016, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$34.65/bbl, a decrease of \$2.37/bbl (6.4%) from the prior week average of \$37.02/bbl. WTI prices are now \$14.12/bbl (29.0%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$48.77/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent—For the week ending January 8th, 2016, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$34.19/bbl, a decrease





of \$2.37/bbl (6.5%) from the week-ago average of \$36.56/bbl. Brent prices are now \$15.28/bbl (30.9%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$49.47/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
