NYSERDA Transportation Fuels Report

Highlights

- The weekly average New York State regular gasoline price increased for the thirteenth week in a row to \$2.449/gallon, and is \$0.433/gallon (15.0%) below last year's weekly average price of \$2.882/gallon.
- Weekly Mid-Atlantic gasoline inventories decreased by 0.1 million barrels (0.3%) since last week to 36.7 million barrels but remain 7.3 million barrels (24.9%) higher than the prior year level of 29.4 million barrels.
- Weekly U.S. crude oil inventories decreased by 3.2 million barrels since last week to 532.5 million barrels and are now 61.9 million barrels (13.1%) above last year's level of 470.6 million barrels.

Retail Prices

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

Regular Gasoline— For the week ending June 6th, 2016 the New York State weekly retail gasoline price averaged \$2.449/gallon, an increase of \$0.011/gallon (0.4%) from last week's average of \$2.438/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$2.882/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.433/gallon (15.0%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

Diesel— For the week ending June 6th, 2016 the New York State weekly retail diesel price averaged \$2.539/gallon, an increase of \$0.017/gallon (0.7%) from last week's average price of \$2.522/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.266/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.727/gallon (22.3%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.

WTI—For the week ending June 3rd, 2016, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$49.07/bbl, an increase of \$0.35/bbl (0.7%) from the prior week average of \$48.72/bbl. WTI prices are now \$10.59/bbl (17.8%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$59.66/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent—For the week ending June 3rd, 2016, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$48.94/bbl, an increase




