## Highlights

- The weekly average New York State regular gasoline price increased for the fourteenth week in a row to $\$ 2.453 /$ gallon, and is $\$ 0.457 /$ gallon (15.7\%) below last year's weekly average price of $\$ 2.910 /$ gallon.
- Weekly Mid-Atlantic gasoline inventories decreased by 0.1 million barrels ( $0.2 \%$ ) since last week to 36.6 million barrels but remain 7.5 million barrels (25.8\%) higher than the prior year level of 29.1 million barrels.
- Weekly U.S. crude oil inventories decreased by 900,000 barrels since last week to 531.5 million barrels and are now 63.6 million barrels (13.6\%) above last year's level of 467.9 million barrels.


## Retail Prices

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."
Regular Gasoline- For the week ending June $13^{\text {th }}$, 2016 the New York State weekly retail gasoline price averaged $\$ 2.453 /$ gallon, an increase of $\$ 0.004 /$ gallon ( $0.1 \%$ ) from last week's average of $\$ 2.449 /$ gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of $\$ 2.910 /$ gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.457/gallon (15.7\%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

Diesel— For the week ending June $13^{\text {th }}, 2016$ the New York State weekly retail diesel price averaged \$2.551/gallon, an increase of \$0.011/gallon (0.4\%) from last week’s average price of $\$ 2.540 /$ gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of $\$ 3.259 /$ gallon, the statewide average has decreased $\$ 0.708 /$ gallon (21.7\%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.

## Crude Oil Spot Prices

WTI—For the week ending June $10^{\text {th }}, 2016$, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged $\$ 50.18 / \mathrm{bbl}$, an increase of $\$ 1.18 / \mathrm{bbl}$ (2.4\%) from the prior week average of \$49.00/bbl. WTI prices are now \$9.89/bbl (16.5\%) below the year-ago weekly average of $\$ 60.07 / \mathrm{bbl}$.

The all-time weekly average high of $\$ 142.52 / \mathrm{bbl}$ occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent-For the week ending June $10^{\text {th }}, 2016$, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged $\$ 49.94 / \mathrm{bbl}$, an increase

 of $\$ 1.03 / \mathrm{bbl}$ (2.1\%) from the week-ago average of \$48.91/bbl. Brent prices are now \$13.30/bbl (21.0\%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$63.24/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
