## **Highlights**

- The weekly average New York State regular gasoline price decreased by \$0.009/gallon since last week and the current price is now \$2.436/gallon, 17.6% lower than the year-ago price of \$2.955/gallon.
- Weekly Mid-Atlantic gasoline inventories increased by 2.6 million barrels (7.4%) since last week to 37.9 million barrels and remain 9.6 million barrels (34.0%) higher than the prior year level of 28.3 million barrels.
- Weekly U.S. crude oil inventories decreased by 4.0 million barrels since last week to 526.6 million barrels and have now decreased by 16.8 million barrels over the past two months.

## **Retail Prices**

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

**Regular Gasoline**— For the week ending June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2016 the New York State weekly retail gasoline price averaged \$2.436/gallon, a decrease of \$0.009/gallon (0.4%) from last week's average of \$2.445/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$2.955/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.519/gallon (17.6%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

**Diesel**— For the week ending June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2016 the New York State weekly retail diesel price averaged \$2.562/gallon, an increase of \$0.001/gallon (0.0%) from last week's average price of \$2.561/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.251/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.689/gallon (21.2%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.


## **Crude Oil Spot Prices**



WTI—For the week ending June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2016, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$48.71/bbl, an increase of \$0.82/bbl (1.7%) from the prior week average of \$47.89/bbl. WTI prices are now \$11.30/bbl (18.8%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$60.01/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

**Brent**—For the week ending June 24<sup>th</sup>, 2016, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$48.12/bbl, an increase of \$0.73/bbl (1.5%) from the week-ago average of





\$47.39/bbl. Brent prices are now \$12.72/bbl (20.9%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$60.84/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
