## Highlights

- The weekly average New York State regular gasoline price decreased by $\$ 0.023 /$ gallon since last week and the current price is now $\$ 2.389 /$ gallon, $18.3 \%$ lower than the year-ago price of $\$ 2.924 /$ gallon.
- Weekly Mid-Atlantic gasoline inventories increased by 0.9 million barrels ( $2.3 \%$ ) since last week to 37.4 million barrels and are now 9.8 million barrels (35.5\%) higher than the prior year level of 27.6 million barrels.
- Weekly U.S. crude oil inventories decreased by 2.3 million barrels since last week to 519.5 million barrels and have now decreased by 23.9 million barrels over the past eleven weeks.


## Retail Prices

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."
Regular Gasoline- For the week ending July $18^{\text {th }}$, 2016 the New York State weekly retail gasoline price averaged $\$ 2.389 /$ gallon, a decrease of $\$ 0.023 /$ gallon (1.0\%) from last week's average of \$2.412/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of $\$ 2.924 /$ gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.535/gallon (18.3\%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

Diesel— For the week ending July 18 ${ }^{\text {th }}$, 2016 the New York State weekly retail diesel price averaged \$2.550/gallon, a decrease of \$0.009/gallon (0.3\%) from last week’s average price of $\$ 2.559 /$ gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of $\$ 3.207 /$ gallon, the statewide average has decreased $\$ 0.657 /$ gallon
 (20.5\%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.

## Crude Oil Spot Prices

WTI—For the week ending July $15^{\text {th }}$, 2016, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged $\$ 45.60 / \mathrm{bbl}$, a decrease of $\$ 0.57 / \mathrm{bbl}$ (1.2\%) from the prior week average of \$46.17/bbl. WTI prices are now \$6.08/bbl (11.8\%) below the year-ago weekly average of $\$ 51.68 / \mathrm{bbl}$.

The all-time weekly average high of $\$ 142.52 / \mathrm{bbl}$ occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent-For the week ending July 15 ${ }^{\text {th }}$, 2016, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged $\$ 45.54 / \mathrm{bbl}$, a decrease of \$0.42/bbl (0.9\%) from the week-ago average of
 $\$ 45.96 / \mathrm{bbl}$. Brent prices are now $\$ 11.63 / \mathrm{bbl}$ (20.3\%) below the year-ago weekly average of $\$ 57.17 / \mathrm{bbl}$.

The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
