## **Highlights**

- The weekly average New York State regular gasoline price increased by \$0.021/gallon since last week and the current price is now \$2.342/gallon, 2.6% lower than the year-ago price of \$2.404/gallon.
- Weekly U.S. crude oil inventories increased by 4.9 million barrels since last week to 474.0 million barrels and are now 37.4 million barrels (8.6%) higher than last year's level of 436.6 million barrels.
- U.S. Energy Information Administration (EIA) reported U.S. crude oil inventories had a change in methodology and no longer include lease stocks. The data reported below reflects this change, which reduced reported crude oil inventories by approximately 30 million barrels.

## **Retail Prices**

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

**Regular Gasoline**— For the week ending October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2016 the New York State weekly retail gasoline price averaged \$2.342/gallon, an increase of \$0.021/gallon (0.9%) from last week's average of \$2.321/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$2.404/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.062/gallon (2.6%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th. 2008.

**Diesel**— For the week ending October 10<sup>th</sup>, 2016 the New York State weekly retail diesel price averaged \$2.549/gallon, an increase of \$0.021/gallon (0.8%) from last week's average price of \$2.528/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$2.815/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.266/gallon (9.4%).

The all-time high of \$5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.

## **Crude Oil Spot Prices**


WTI—For the week ending October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2016, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$49.48/bbl, an increase of \$2.93/bbl (6.3%) from the prior week average of \$46.55/bbl. WTI prices are now \$1.12/bbl (2.3%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$48.36/bbl.


The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

**Brent**—For the week ending October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2016, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$49.52/bbl, an increase

of \$2.78/bbl (5.9%) from the week-ago average of \$46.74/bbl. Brent prices are now \$1.81/bbl (3.5%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$51.33/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
