- The weekly average New York State diesel gasoline price is \$3.205/gallon, \$0.013/gallon (0.4%) below last week's average of \$3.218/gallon. Prices are \$0.472/gallon (17.3%) above the year ago average of \$2.733/gallon.
- The weekly average New York State regular gasoline price is \$2.747/gallon, \$0.020/gallon (0.7%) below last week's average of \$2.767/gallon. Prices are \$0.268/gallon (10.8%) above the year-ago price of \$2.479/gallon.

Retail Prices

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

Regular Gasoline— For the week ending February 19th, 2018 the New York State weekly retail gasoline price averaged \$2.747/gallon, a decrease of \$0.020/gallon (0.7%) from last week's average of \$2.767/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$2.479/gallon, the statewide average has increased \$0.268/gallon (10.8%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

Diesel— For the week ending February 19th, 2018 the New York State weekly retail diesel price averaged \$3.205/gallon, a decrease of \$0.013/gallon (0.4%) from last week's average price of \$3.218/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$2.733/gallon the statewide average has increased \$0.472/gallon (17.3%).

The all-time high of 5.138/gallon occurred on June 18th, 2008.





WTI – For the week ending February 16th, 2018, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$60.56/bbl, a decrease of \$1.45/bbl (2.3%) from the week-ago average of \$62.01/bbl. WTI prices are now \$7.34/bbl (13.8%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$53.22/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent -For the week ending February 16th, 2018, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$62.72/bbl, a decrease of \$2.78/bbl (4.2%) from the week-ago average of \$65.50/bbl. Brent prices are now \$8.26/bbl (15.2%) above the year-ago weekly average of \$54.46/bbl.





The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
