- **Incentives:** Applicant may be eligible for ETAC-CI Program incentives from NYSERDA. Where applicable, incentives are only available for the installation of new equipment that has not been installed (partially or completely) prior to NYSERDA's approval of the Application. Where applicable, incentives will not be provided directly to Demonstration Host Site but are paid to the Applicant.
- Access to Site: For quality control/monitoring and verification (M&V) purposes, Demonstration Host Site must provide NYSERDA or its representatives with reasonable access to the site for the purposes of pre- and post-installation data collection, M&V, and installation inspection.
 Demonstration Host Site will make building energy usage data available to NYSERDA and/or its representatives.
