Great news for your business. Contracting in New York isn't what it used to be.

You can drive yourself crazy trying to figure out exactly where the contracting market is headed. Or you can take opportunities as they come. Here's a big one:

Participating in Home Performance with ENERGY STAR® will put your business at the head of the line to win energy efficiency contracting work in your area.

Home Performance with ENERGY STAR is a nationwide program that promotes a building science-based approach to energy efficiency. In New York State it is administered by the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA). The program's mission is to help New Yorkers make their homes more energy efficient by offering a variety of incentives.

Passage of the Green Jobs – Green New York Act of 2009 strengthened and expanded those incentives. They now include free or reduced-cost home energy assessments, low-interest financing and cashback incentives for qualified upgrades. Additional grants are available for income-qualified homeowners.

Home Performance with connects homeowners with contractors qualified to complete comprehensive energy efficiency upgrades. That's where you come in. To qualify for incentives, consumers are required to hire participating Home Performance with ENERGY STAR co accredited by the Building Performance Institute (BPI).

One of them could be you.

New Yorkers spend \$4 - \$6 million a month on Home Performance with ENERGY STAR contracting work.

Participating Home Performance with ENERGY STAR contractors tap directly into a large and rapidly expanding market. They bring in more jobs. They generate more revenue. And they have the credibility it takes to earn homeowners' trust and become a central energy efficiency resource in the long term.

Demand is high and getting higher.

Participation in the program has been expanding each year, with no sign of slowing down. New York State is developing a new on-bill payment program in 2012. Homeowners will be able to pay back their loans through their utility bills, with monthly payments not to exceed 1/12 of the projected annual savings. If the house is sold before the loan is paid off, the balance transfers to the new homeowner.

On-bill payment is expected to significantly increase the demand for energy efficiency and make it easier for homeowners to tackle larger projects.

HOW IT WORKS



Get accredited by BPI

BPI sets the national technical standards for contractors in the building performance contracting trade. In addition to signing a program partnership agreement with NYSERDA, contracting companies must be accredited by BPI in order to join the Home Performance with ENERGY STAR program.

To get started, technicians on your team will need to earn

Building Analyst (BA) Certification covers the basics of building science, the home assessment process and the use of diagnostic and safety testing equipment.

BPI Specialist Certification includes four higher-level options: Envelope Professional, Heating Professional, Air Conditioning and Heat Pump Professional, and Manufactured Housing Professional.

BA certification is required before a technician can earn Specialist certification. BPI certification lasts for three years. All certification tests consist of a written and in-field component. Technicians may earn BA and Specialist certifications on the same day.

BPI Accreditation applies to a company and must be renewed

- Have at least one technician on staff who has both a BA and Specialist certification
- Carry liability and workers' compensation insurance
- Use a BPI qualified quality assurance system

 Perform all work to BPI standards and report on a semi-annual basis to BPI



STEP Get outfitted

In addition to earning BPI accreditation, you'll need to purchase diagnostic equipment, including a blower door, computer software and other tools. You may also want to invest in equipment to help you complete energy efficiency projects like blowing in insulation. Home Performance contractors are eligible for financial incentives that help reduce equipment costs. See Step 6 to learn more.




There are three primary ways Home Performance with ENERGY STAR contractors market themselves: through their sales staff, through NYSERDA and through advertising and marketing communications.

Participating contractors have access to cooperative advertising funds and consumer education materials.

Perform comprehensive home energy assessments

The comprehensive home energy assessment is a top-to-bottom examination of a home's energy efficiency performance. For consumers, this is the critical first step in the energy efficiency upgrade process—and a requirement to access attractive NYSERDA incentives. For contractors, the home assessment is a direct connection with potential customers already interested in energy efficiency. NYSERDA pays contractors the full cost of the assessment for most homes. Successful contractors approach the assessment as a sales opportunity.



At the conclusion of every home assessment, you will provide your customers with a report explaining the energy efficiency performance of their home. This report becomes a customized, prioritized roadmap for a range of improvements. Instead of one-shot work on a single aspect of your customers' homes, you'll develop long-term relationships where you provide genuine solutions to problems. In terms of revenue and customer satisfaction, that's a big difference.





The payoff to becoming a Home Performance with ENERGY STAR contractor goes beyond an expanded service offering, more leads and more profit. The program includes built-in incentives, so participating contractors can see an immediate return on investment.

Home Performance contractor incentives include:

Advanced Modeling Incentives

Earn a reimbursement of five percent of the value of eligible measures installed, up to \$500.

General Contractor/Referral Incentives

Refer work to another Home Performance contractor and earn an incentive worth two percent of the price of eligible measures the subcontractor installs, up to \$400 per project.

Diagnostic Equipment Incentives

Join the program or expand to a new region and you can earn a one-time reimbursement of 20 percent of the cost of eligible diagnostic equipment purchases, up to \$4,000.

Cooperative Advertising Incentives

Join the program and meet specified spending and production levels and you'll qualify to have a percentage of approved advertising costs paid for by NYSERDA.


