General Description of Project (250 words or more):

The Bid Facility is a 200 MW zero-emission solar energy facility that will assist the State in meeting the goals of the Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act, which includes obtaining 70% of energy generation from renewable sources by 2030 and significantly reducing greenhouse gas emissions. Other positive aspects of the facility include diversification of energy supplies, new employment (both temporary construction employment and full-time operations and maintenance positions), increased revenue to the Towns of Brasher and Massena, the County, and local schools, payments to participating landowners, support of the local hospitality industry and purchase of local supplies and goods. The project is fortunate to have broad public support, as evidence by this quote in the AHJ letter from Town of Brasher supervisor Mark Peets, " Like many legacy farming communities throughout Upstate New York, we have seen our small family farms close in droves. Large industrial operations also have cutback, leaving a significant hole in our community. Thankfully, Boralex's development has provided a critical lifeline at a time when many farmers and large landowners are questioning their futures. Having spoken directly to many of the participating landowners, I know how critical the project's success is to their financial wellbeing and their ability to continue farming their land both now and in the future. On a personal note, I attended the optional open house Boralex held in April of 2024 and was struck by the Boralex team's willingness to engage and their knowledge of the project and community. It is evident that Boralex did their research, has made a commitment to integrate themselves into the town, and has shown that they are good corporate stewards and excellent neighbors."
