General Description of Project (250 words or more):

Trelina Solar Energy Center (Trelina) is owned 100% by Trelina Solar Energy Center, LLC, an indirect, wholly owned subsidiary of NextEra Energy Resources, LLC. Trelina Solar Energy Center will be a solar photovoltaic facility with a maximum generating capability of 79.8 megawatts (MW) on land leased on private property, mainly classified as agricultural and has been used as such in the past. The project was granted a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need pursuant to Article 10 of the Public Service Law on November 30, 2021.

The Trelina Solar Energy Center will be located in the Town of Waterloo, Seneca County, New York. The interconnection site will be located within the project site utilizing the existing transmission lines that traverse it. The Town regulates development of solar energy projects through its solar energy law. In accordance with Trelina’s Article 10 Certificate, Trelina will construct and operate the facility in accordance with the substantive provisions of the Town’s applicable laws with the exception of the substantive requirements of the solar energy law that were determined by the Siting Board to be unreasonably burdensome in the view of existing technology, or consumer needs. Trelina will also comply with the numerous conditions included in the project's Article 10 Certificate that govern construction and operation of the facility.

Existing land uses within and surrounding the project site consist predominantly of agricultural fields with scattered areas of trees. A review of historical aerial mapping indicates that there have been no changes to these land uses in the recent past. There are very few residential uses within the immediate vicinity of the project site. A few industrial uses are located to the southwest, scattered commercial uses to the south and a golf course is located northwest of the project site.
