MPP Compliance Pathway – New Construction

Scenario A

Application accepted into MPP and a satisfactory DOB application* is submitted <u>before</u> January 1, 2015:

•Target: Design and model must meet 15% better than ASHRAE 90.1-2007

Scenario B

Satisfactory application submitted to DOB between January 1, 2015 and October 2, 2016:

•Target: Model can either meet 15% better than ASHRAE 90.1-2010 <u>OR</u>, if you've already started the model, 20% better than ASHRAE 90.1-2007

Scenario C

Satisfactory application submitted to DOB <u>on or</u> <u>after</u> October 3, 2016:

•Target: Design must meet new code requirements; for the purposes of MPP, models shall demonstrate savings of 19% better than ASHRAE 90.1-2010

*A satisfactory application means that your architectural, mechanical and plumbing plans have been substantially completed. If the DOB reviews your plans and finds they are not substantially complete, they may require you to update your design to the new code.
