Uncommitted megawatts remain in various MW Block sectors, regions and blocks, due to past solar project cancellations. We are now adding those uncommitted megawatts to the current MW Block within the same sector and region so they will be available for use.

The following current block is affected:

 Long Island Residential (Block 4): Increase from 68 MW to a total of 77 MW
