Current focus:

- Community Purchasing (Aggregation, "Solarize")
- Residential and Small-Medium Non-Residential (small business, nonprofit, municipal)
- Some potential for 200 kW+ projects



Other areas:

- Shared Solar (Community Shared Solar)
- Crowdfunding and group investment



Key points:

- No additional incentives for installationstandard NY-Sun incentives apply
- Technical assistance, resources, and funding for organizers (typically municipality or local group)
- Schools can access funding for outreach/community education, classroom education curriculum
