# Registration Process

## NY-Sun Contractor Application Form (new)

Option A – Residential and Small Commercial (Formerly PON 2112)

Option B – Commercial and Industrial

Option C – Both

# Registration Criteria for >200 kW

## Project Experience

Provide information for three commercial-scale projects interconnected in the past three years that, in aggregate, sum to at least 500kW. These must be verifiable references for specific projects and be accompanied by a brief description of the systems installed and the applicant's role in the project (via NYSERDA form)

OR

## Previous Participation

Indicate that your organization has successfully completed a PV project under any of the prior Competitive PONs that has been reporting data to the NYSERDA DG Integrated Data System website for at least three months.

	3 Projects Totaling 500 kW OR 1 project reporting to CDH	3 Projects (any size) OR 1 project reporting to CDH	Installer Credentials

# Registration Criteria – Project Experience

Project information collected via NYSERDA application

Projects do not have to be in NY

Projects do have to be grid-connected

Contractor must have had a significant role in the project

- e.g.
- Finance
  - Developer
  - EPC
  - Operations
  - Engineering / Design

# Registration Process

Existing Contractors/Installers in the Residential Program do not need to re-apply to continue working in the Residential Program.

# Registration Process

New Application available by February 18 via NY-Sun website

Complete application and return with attachments via e-mail

NYSERDA will process applications and e-mail applicant with status

Approved applicants will also receive log-in credentials from PowerClerk
