Improve your bottom line with no-cost technical assistance

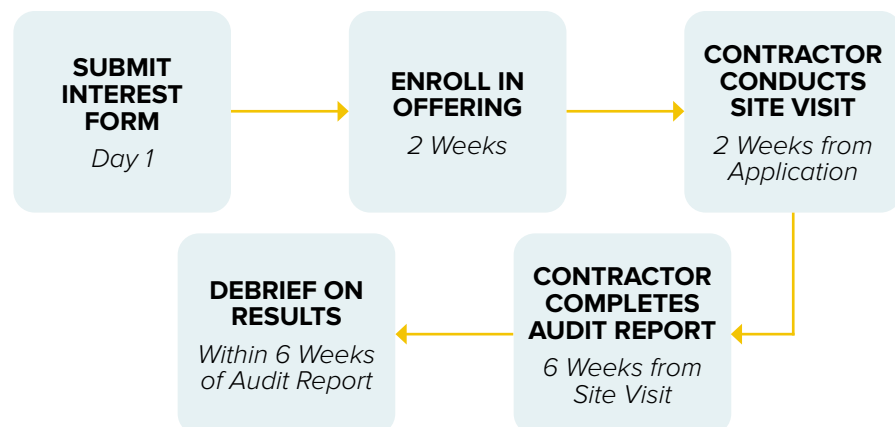
The Small Affordable Multifamily Energy Studies (SAMES) offering provides eligible affordable multifamily building owners with a no-cost energy study that analyzes ways to reduce the buildings energy costs.

An objective, site specific energy study, conducted by a NYSERDA contractor assesses the building's envelope, lighting, and HVAC systems to identify opportunities to improve building efficiency and integration of clean energy technologies. These opportunities can then be integrated into capital planning for the building. NYSERDA's contractor supports building owners through each step of the study.

Eligibility

Multifamily buildings must meet the following eligibility criteria to qualify for funding:

- Small to medium-sized buildings (50,000 residential square feet or less)
- Meet affordable housing requirements
 - At least 25% of residential units are, or are expected to be, occupied by households earning not more than 80% of the area or State median income, whichever is higher.
