Flexible Technical Assistance (FlexTech) Program Revised - Program Opportunity Notice (PON) 4192

Dear Consultants & Customers,

As New York begins to reopen under New York Forward, NYSEERDA continues to seek solutions that can support our partners and can help jump-start our clean energy economy.

As you may be aware, the Flexible Technical Assistance (FlexTech) Program Opportunity Notice (PON) 4192 offers cost-shared technical services to help customers make informed energy efficiency and clean heating and cooling decisions. To provide greater assistance during this challenging time, effective June 15, 2020 through December 31, 2020, FlexTech will offer up to 100% cost-sharing upon installation of measure(s) recommended through a NYSEERDA-approved FlexTech study, as outlined in the new [PON 4192 Program Addendum](#). All other program eligibility requirements, program parameters, and limitations as outlined in PON 4192 remain the same.

Summary of Program Changes

Up to 100% Study Cost-Sharing with Proof of Installation

- NYSEERDA will reimburse FlexTech customers the remaining portion of their eligible energy efficiency or clean heating and cooling study costs upon installation of measure(s) recommended through an approved FlexTech energy study.
- Reimbursement amount will be paid at the lesser of:
 - Balance of eligible study costs, not to exceed 100% of the total qualifying study cost; OR
 - Installed measure costs

Reimbursement Eligibility

- The FlexTech application must have been submitted between June 15, 2020 and December 31, 2020.
- The installed measure(s) must be listed as recommended by the customer's energy consultant in the NYSEERDA approved final report.

- Installation of new measures reliant on fossil fuels are ineligible for reimbursement, however investments which reduce fossil fuel consumption through heat recovery or other controls may be eligible for reimbursement.
