As New York State recovers from the COVID-19 pandemic under Governor Cuomo's strong leadership, NYSERDA continues to offer solutions that can support our partners and can help build our clean energy economy.

As you may be aware, the Flexible Technical Assistance (FlexTech) Program Opportunity Notice (PON) 4192 offers cost-shared technical services to help customers make informed energy efficiency and clean heating and cooling decisions. For applications submitted through December 31, 2020, NYSERDA currently offers up to 100 percent study cost-sharing upon installation of measure(s) recommended through a NYSERDA-approved FlexTech study. To continue to provide you with assistance during this challenging time NYSERDA is extending this offer through December 31, 2021, as outlined in the updated <u>PON 4192 Program</u> <u>Addendum</u>.

All other program eligibility requirements, program parameters, and limitations as outlined in PON 4192 remain the same.

### **Summary of Program Changes**

The Flexible Technical Assistance (FlexTech) Addendum to PON 4192 has been extended from December 31, 2020 to December 31, 2021.

### Up to 100 Percent Study Cost-Sharing with Proof of Installation

 NYSERDA will reimburse FlexTech customers the remaining portion of their eligible energy efficiency or clean heating and cooling study costs upon installation of measure(s) recommended through an approved FlexTech energy study.

- Reimbursement amount will be paid at the lesser of:
  - Balance of eligible study costs, not to exceed 100% of the total qualifying study cost; OR
  - Installed measure costs

# **Reimbursement Eligibility**

The following changes have been made to the reimbursement eligibility under the Flexible Technical Assistance (FlexTech) Addendum to PON 4192, effective for applications submitted on or after January 1, 2021:

- Reimbursement is not available for the installation of lighting or lighting control measures.
- Multifamily facilities:
  - Must evaluate electrification (i.e. clean heating and cooling measures) or electrification readiness as part of the NYSERDA-approved FlexTech scope of work in order to be eligible for reimbursement.
  - Level 1+ studies of multifamily facilities are ineligible for reimbursement.
