NYSERDA Program Modifications

- NYSERDA has implemented extensions of program deadlines or modifications to project milestones in recognition that projects may not be able to meet these requirements due to the New York State on PAUSE Executive Order.
- NYSERDA is currently examining all Program offerings to identify project types for which interim milestones can be established so that a percentage of completion payment can be provided for those projects deemed to have minimal risk of noncompletion.
- Alternative approaches, such as virtual auditing and targeted incentives for sectors most severely impacted by COVID-19, are being reviewed and discussed to provide opportunities during the PAUSE Order.
