

NYSERDA Accessibility Requirements

Accessible content ensures those with disabilities or impairments have the access to NYSERDA information and opportunities.

NYSERDA requires contractors producing content intended to be posted to the Web to adhere to New York State's accessibility policy [NYS-P08-005](#).

New York State's accessibility standards require compliance with [Subpart B, section 1194.22](#) and [Subpart C, section 1194.31](#) of [Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973](#), as amended 29 U.S.C. § 794 (d).

NYSERDA's Accessibility Review Process

NYSERDA reviews content intended to be posted to the Web for compliance to Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. Web content includes not only Web pages but downloadable and streaming resources such as PDFs, audio, and video. Contractors should allow time for review and remediation prior to publishing.
