Highlights

- The weekly average New York State regular gasoline retail price decreased \$0.024/gallon (0.9%) since last week to \$2.804/gallon. Current prices are \$0.188/gallon (6.3%) below the year-ago price of \$2.992/gallon.
- Mid-Atlantic ultra-low sulfur (ULS) distillate inventories decreased 0.8 million barrels (3.2%) since last week to 22.5 million barrels. Inventories are now 7.9% above the year-ago level but 12.1% below the 5-year average.
- U.S. gasoline demand increased 0.3 million barrels per day (2.8%) since last week to 9.9 million barrels per day. This is 3.8% higher than the 5-year average.

Retail Prices

Prices are from the "AAA Daily Fuel Gauge Report."

Regular Gasoline—For the week ending August 26th, 2019, the New York State weekly retail gasoline price averaged \$2.804/gallon, a decrease of \$0.024/gallon (0.9%) from last week's average of \$2.828/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$2.992/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.188/gallon (6.3%).

The all-time high of \$4.309/gallon occurred on July 9th, 2008.

Diesel— For the week ending on August 26th, 2019, the New York State weekly retail diesel price averaged \$3.176/gallon, a decrease of \$0.011/gallon (0.3%) from last week's average of \$3.187/gallon. Compared to the year earlier price of \$3.318/gallon, the statewide average has decreased \$0.142/gallon (4.3%).

The all-time high of 5.138/gallon occurred on June 18^{th} , 2008.


Crude Oil Spot Prices



WTI – For the week ending August 23rd, 2019, WTI crude oil spot prices averaged \$55.50/bbl, an increase of \$0.19/bbl (0.3%) from the week-ago average of \$55.31/bbl. WTI prices are now \$12.60/bbl (18.5%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$68.10/bbl.

The all-time weekly average high of \$142.52/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.

Brent - For the week ending August 23rd, 2019, Brent crude oil spot prices averaged \$59.57/bbl, an increase of \$1.32/bbl (2.3%) from the week-ago average of \$58.25/bbl. Brent prices are now \$13.20/bbl (18.1%) below the year-ago weekly average of \$72.77/bbl.





The all-time weekly average high of \$141.07/bbl occurred the week ending July 4th, 2008.
